

Bicycles

The system provides in this first phase, with 336 bikes, with the colors of the Municipal Transport Company of Palma (EMT), ie, blue, white and green. And only 5,000 users are enabled.

The characteristics of the bike are:

- > Gear shift 3-speed, integrated
- > Lighting system adapted to the rules, with a headlight and a driver behind
- > Ring
- > Brakes front and rear.
- > Tyres reinforced with a design to avoid much of the wheel mounting holes and an anti-theft
- > Front basket
- > Seat adjustable anti-theft system

Stations

In total, Bicipalma provided in this first phase of 28 stations, which are located in 15 different neighborhoods in Palma:

Foners, Pere Garau, Marquis of FontSanta, Archduke, Buenos Aires, the Fort, the Camp d'en Serralta, Santa Catalina, Jaime III, Born, Square Skating, Cort, St. Nicholas, the Union and the Market. (See location map)

Each station has a point of interaction with the user (PIU), the system through computer screens and software that allows citizens to take the bike.

This item provides the closest empty stations and lets you enter information on the status of bicycles or check the malfunctioning or damage of any item on the bike which conditions the operation, among others.

In addition, each station has a video surveillance camera to prevent vandalism.

Circulation patterns Bicipalma

It is very important to respect the Municipal Traffic Ordinance and the rules of the Traffic Department.

Bicipalma bikes must go through the bike lane. Failing that, they should always travel on the road and not on sidewalks. Sidewalks are for pedestrians and, therefore, bicycles should not move in them. (**Offense**)

In pedestrian areas, parks or downtown areas ACIRE cyclists can only go at the same speed as pedestrians. Exceeding this speed is an **infraction**.

When a road has more than one lane the rider must go by the lane right next to the curb. If there is one lane for buses and taxis bicycles must ride alongside these lanes.

Cyclists should not move to the side holding or any part of a motor vehicle. (**Violation**)

It is very important to respect the traffic rules in order to move safely and avoid accidents.

By city, it is not mandatory that cyclists wear helmets.

However, you should take to prevent accidents.

Outside the city itself that is compulsory to wear a helmet.

Are compulsory in the city lights front and back on, when driving at night.

Everyone must respect the traffic signals to move in accordance with current regulations.

In the bike lane is a sign that riders must follow.
